

## June 19, 2018 Stop Greenhouse Landfill Meeting

1. According to Bryan French with Lone Star Legal Aid, they have enough people signed up to be able to help fight the landfill.
2. Gary Brown has applied for a 501-C tax exempt status. Stated that we may not need one since Lone Star has become involved. We can raise \$5,000.00 per year without the tax exempt. White and Chase are working with Gary to get our by-laws written.
3. Gary shared pictures of our trip to Austin for the hearing on landfills. District 29 Texas House of Representative Ed Thompson, was shown to have a great interest in the landfill issues. Blue Ridge Landfill in Pearland is in his district. We attended this meeting recommended by TCE.
4. Texas Campaign for the Environment (TCE) also suggested to Gary that we make an appointment with Texas State Senator, Joan Huffman to voice our concerns. Gary is trying to set up an appointment.
5. Gary shared videos of the flooding in Rolling Green and Barker Ridge and that water should be draining into ditch U100-01, not into subdivisions. If that water touches the waste, it would become contaminated.
6. Gary will be going to a bond meeting at the community center with residents and the Harris County Flood Control representatives.
7. Gary is questioning if the use of an odor control system at the landfill, to control the "rotten egg" smell of Hydrogen Sulfide is legal. They should be performing a daily cover every day. If they are using the odor control system, do they now believe that they do not have to perform a daily cover? Has this process been approved?
8. Gary found out that pollution control inspectors do not take samples of the Hydrogen Sulfide that the landfill produces. How can they prove that this is not an issue?
